



## ASN CLASS OF 2022 FELLOWS

To be inducted as a Fellow of the American Society for Nutrition is the highest honor that the Society bestows. Scientists who have had distinguished careers in the field of nutrition and are at least sixty-five years of age are eligible for consideration.

Applications should be submitted by the individual interested in being considered for the ASN Class of 2022 Fellows.

The ASN Class of 2022 Fellows will be honored at NUTRITION 2022 LIVE ONLINE, ASN's annual meeting which will be held virtually from June 14-16, 2022.

The deadline for applications is **January 28, 2022**.

### Application and Selection Process

All applications must be submitted via the [ASN Foundation Portal](#). Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Applications will be retained for 2 years. Applications received will be considered for 2022 and 2023 Fellows selection.

Confidential selection juries are appointed each year. Juries rate the candidates based on the award criteria.

### Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a scientist who has had a distinguished career in the field of nutrition
- Be at least sixty-five years of age

### Applicant Guidelines

The following information will be required during the submission process. *Please note that ASN recommends the application information first be written and saved in a Word document and then copied and pasted into the appropriate boxes during the application process.*

- Applicant's contact information
- Letter(s) of support author contact information
- Application information:
  - Personal statement summarizing contributions to field of nutrition science/practice/education (up to 500 words).
  - Description/list of leadership roles and service within ASN and/or the broader nutrition community
  - Description/list of honors and awards

- Required uploads (in PDF format)
  - Letter(s) of support (maximum of 2 letters) to address the following:
    - Impact of applicant's contributions to the field
    - Demonstrated excellence and/or commitment
    - Reputation in the nutrition science/practice/education community
  - Curriculum vitae of the applicant
