Application Requirements

All nominations must be submitted via the <u>ASN Foundation Portal</u>. Incomplete or late nominations will not be considered.

*The following information will be required during the application process:

- Confirmation of ASN membership
- Confirmation of Continental US-based location
- Diversity demographic data
- Degree in progress and expected year of completion
- Area of study
- Current cumulative GPA

- Required upload: Current resume or CV (PDF)
- Personal statement of applicant's educational and career objectives and how participation in this opportunity would benefit personal goals (no more than 3,500 characters not including spaces)
- Prior involvement with ASN (e.g., volunteer leadership position(s), abstracts presented, manuscripts submitted)

Selected scholars will be expected to attend this CRN Science in Session event in person from October 2-4, 2023. Scholars will be provided standard coach roundtrip airfare within continental US, 2-night hotel accommodations and a daily stipend for ground transportation and other incidentals. Flight and hotel accommodations must be made through the ASNF. Additional instructions will be provided to the selected scholars.
